# eCQM 50: Closing the Referral Loop



## **Measure Overview**

eCQM 50: Closing the Referral Loop	
Description	Percentage of patients with referrals, regardless of age, for which the referring provider receives a report from the provider to whom the patient was referred
Exclusion	None
Points Available	Up to 10



# **Measure Specifications**

# Denominator A qualifying encounter during the measurement period AND A referral order is placed on or before October 31 during the measurement period Numerator Consultant report received OR completed after first referral order performed

## **Measure Special Considersatons**

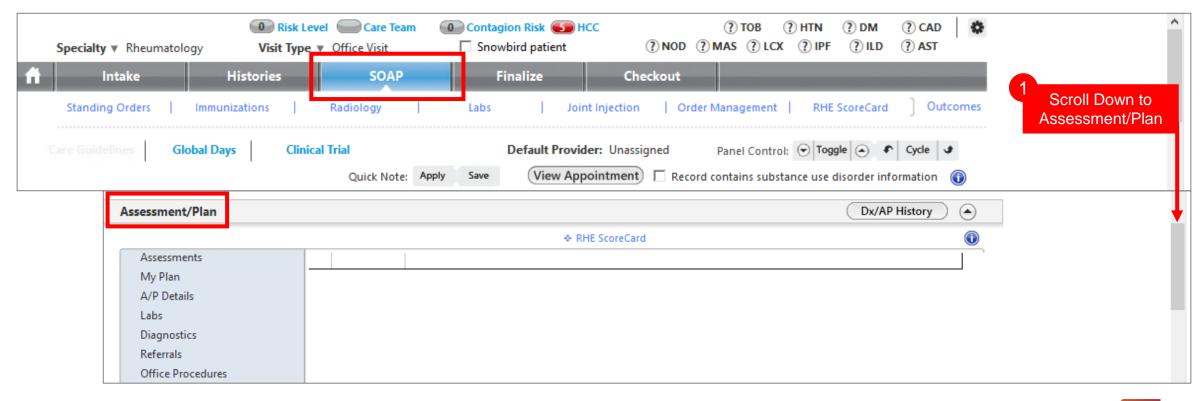
- Referral: A request from one clinician to another clinician for evaluation, treatment, or co-management of a patient's condition
- Report: A written document prepared by the clinician/staff to whom the patient is referred and provides summary of care information about findings, diagnostics, assessments and/or plans of care and is provided to the referring clinician
- The clinician who refers the patient to another clinician is the clinician that is held accountable for the performance of this measure
- When documenting a referral using the Referrals
   Order window, Podiatry specialty and cardiac rehabilitation therapy are not in the value set and will not meet the criteria for this measure

- Only the first referral made between January 1 –
   October 31 of the measurement period will be considered for this measure to allow ample time for the referring clinician to collect the consult report by the end of the measurement period
- If there are multiple referrals for a patient during the measurement period, use the first referral
- It is possible to document "communication" of the report after the measurement period, if it is documented after the referral
  - To satisfy the measure for reporting, the communication needs to occur before the deadline for submitting data

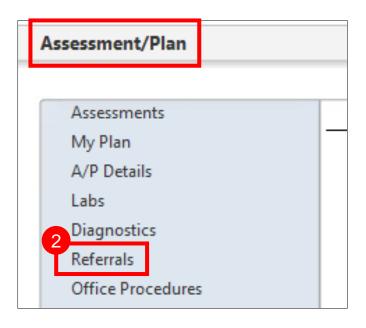
- From the SOAP Template
- 1. Scroll to the **Assessment/Plan** tab

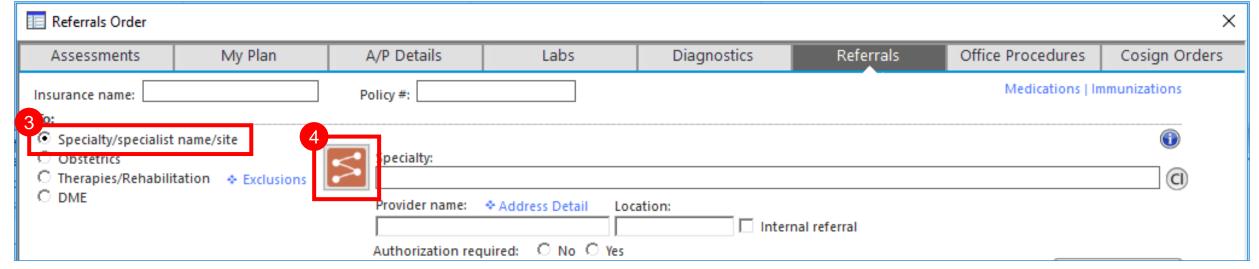




#### Part 1: Documenting the Referral

- From the Assessment/Plan tab
  - 2. Click Referrals
  - 3. Click **Specialty/Specialist name/site** radio button
  - 4. Click on the orange NextGen Share button

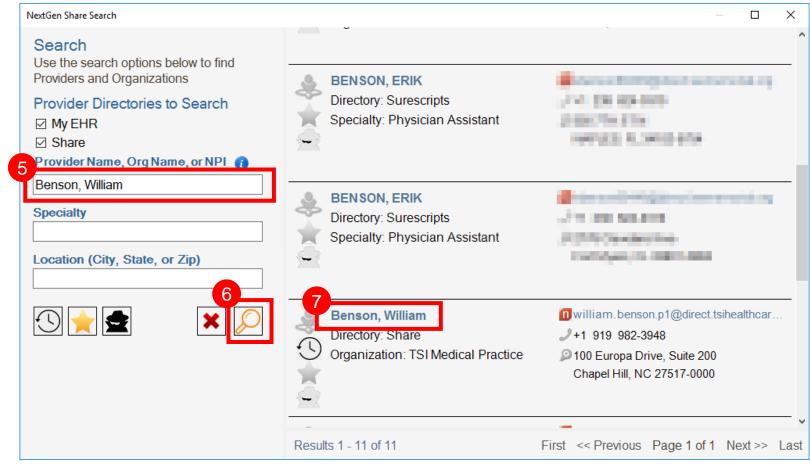






# Part 1: Documenting the Referral

- 5. Type the name of provider to whom you are referring in the **NextGen Share** pop-up
- Click on the Magnifying Glass
- 7. Select the provider to whom you are referring to the list on the right



**QP Tip**: You can search by Last name, First name or partial name or NPI or full Direct address



#### Part 1: Documenting the Referral

- Document the appropriate specialty
- In the **Diagnosis**: section, click in the **Description** field and select the appropriate diagnosis
- 10. Click Add
- 11. Click the referral in the grid to highlight the item

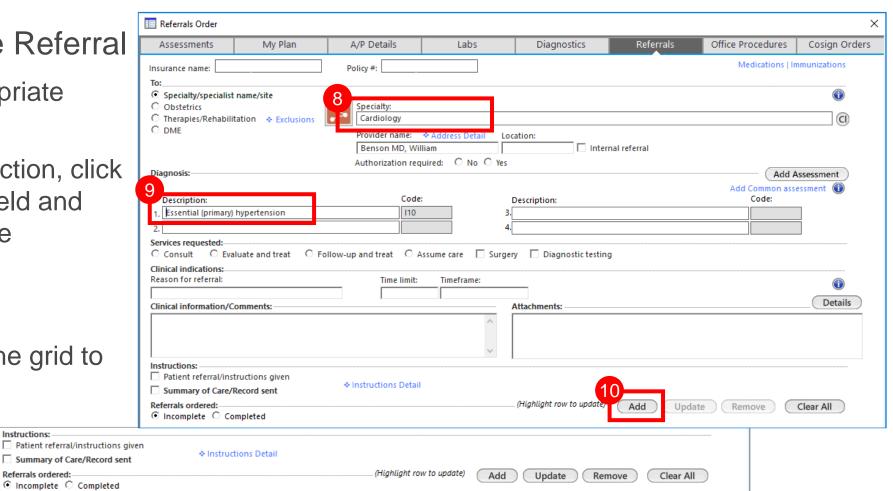

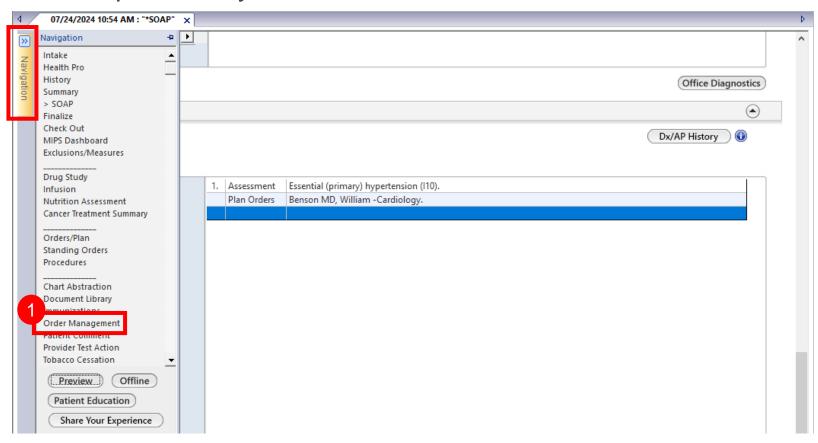
Part 2: Closing the Referral Loop

From the Navigation Bar

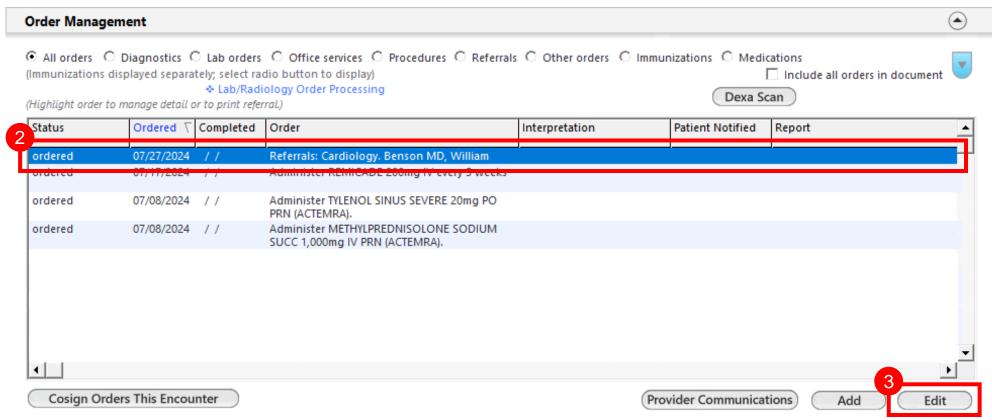
1. Click on Order Management

- 3. Click **Edit**

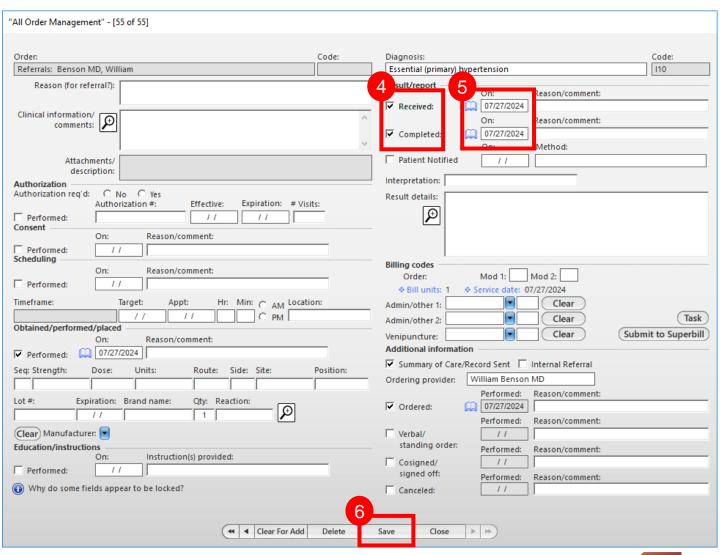




#### Part 2: Closing the Referral Loop

- 4. Click on either the **Received**OR Completed checkboxes
- 5. Enter the **Date** for the corresponding checkbox
- 6. Click Save
