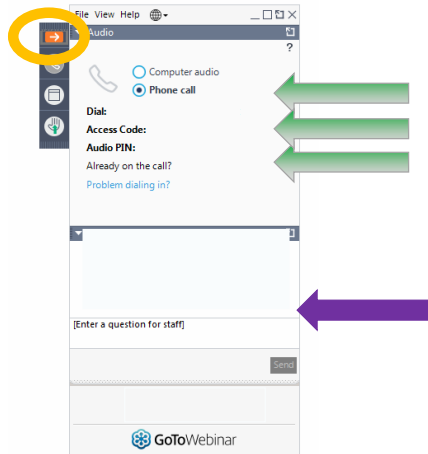

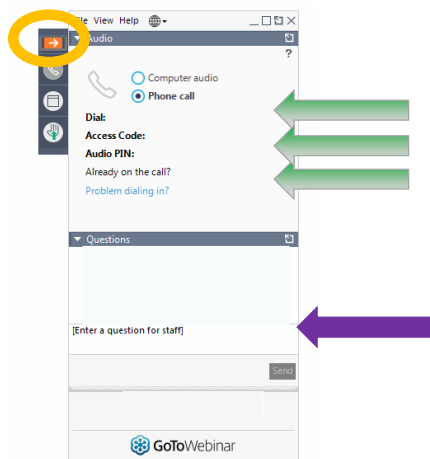

Why Carequality Data Share

The Problem with Sharing Patient Information Today:

- EHRs do not work well together
- Patient recollection of health history is unreliable and incomplete
- Responding to and requesting medical records is very time consuming
- Faxing records results in extra clicks and manual data entry
- Prevents patients from scheduling timely appointments

Why Carequality Data Share

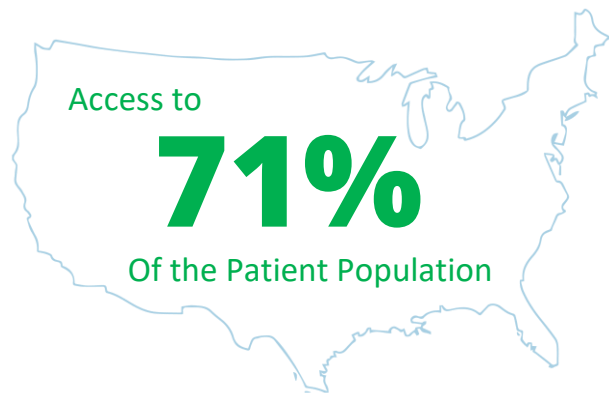
With Carequality Data Share:

- Save time identifying patient visit locations
- Quickly receive historical records at the point of care
- Automatically request records to reduce phone calls and faxes
- Integrate into current workflow
- Promote and support value-based care models

How Carequality Data Share Works

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**CAREQUALITY

continuously collects patient demographic
information from connected practices.



**CAREQUALITY
DATA SHARE**

searches the network every night for patients with an upcoming appointment.

**CAREQUALITY
DATA SHARE**

creates a list of available documents when a match is found.



CAREQUALITY DATA SHARE

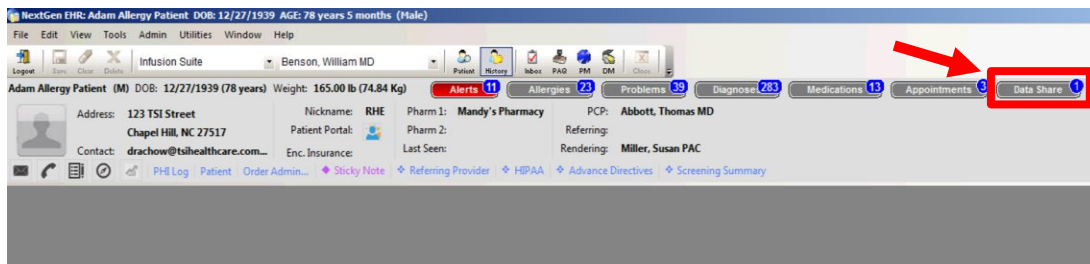
allows for easy access and importation of documents into the patient's EHR chart.



How Carequality Data Share Works

Available Records Display in Patients EHR Chart

- If a match is found and records are available to view for the patient, they will be listed in the Patients Chart → Patient Information Toolbar → Data Share



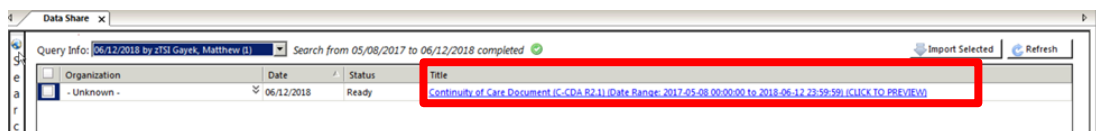
Patient arrives at your practice. Clinical team reviews documents and reconciles information with the patient.



How Carequality Data Share Works

Clinical Team Can Review & Import Documents

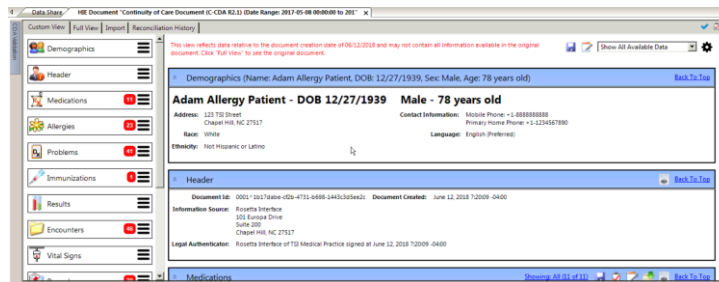
- When the patient arrives to their appointment the documents can be reviewed and reconciled into the patients NextGen EHR chart

How Carequality Data Share Works

Automatic Retrieval and Documentation of Records

- If a patient of yours is treated at another practice that is participating in Carequality and a request is made, the records will be processed automatically and captured in the PHI Log!

Note: The practice must retain related documentation and tracking log for each patient for six (6) years from the date of its creation or the date when it last was in effect, whichever is later.

The Future of Interoperability

Carequality Data Share focuses on interoperability by connecting all EHR systems with the Carequality Interoperability Framework.

- Avoid interoperability issues
- CMS is challenging people to get rid of faxing by year 2020
- Commonwell Health Alliance will be joining the Carequality Interoperability Framework by the end of 2018

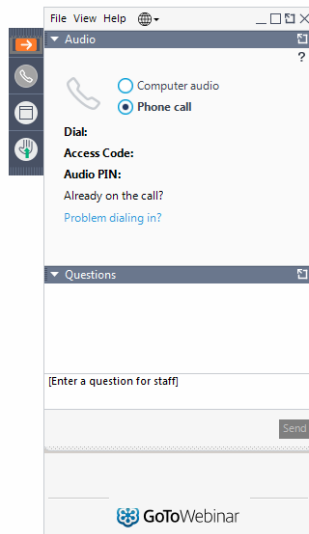
